

Step 1: Unpack

Make sure the following items came in this package.

- Canz wireless speaker
- USB charging cable
- 3.5mm audio cable

Step 2: Charge up!

Before you start using your Canz speaker, you need to charge its built-in battery.

Plug the included USB charging cable into the DC IN jack on the back of the speaker.



Plug the other end of the charging cable into a USB power source (like a computer or a USB charger).

The charging indicator on the back of the speaker illuminates while the speaker is charging. It turns off when the speaker is fully charged.



Step 3: Turn on

The on/off switch is on the bottom of the speaker. Flip it to the ON position to turn the speaker on.



The speaker beeps and the PAIR light on the front of the speaker starts blinking.



Step 4: Pair + Connect

Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone or other device.



Make sure the PAIR light on the front of the speaker is blinking rapidly. (If it isn't, press and hold the PAIR button until the speaker beeps.)



If you've previously paired your phone or other Bluetooth device with this Canz speaker, the speaker will automatically attempt to reconnect to that device when you switch the speaker on. If you want to pair to a new device, press and hold the PAIR button on the speaker until the speaker beeps.

Choose CANZ from the pairing options on your smartphone. (If it's not in the list, choose "Scan" from your phone's Bluetooth menu.)



The speaker beeps when it's finished pairing and connecting to your smartphone. The PAIR light on the front of the speaker turns solid blue.



Note: The process of enabling Bluetooth and connecting varies from device to device. See your device's owners manual for more information and specific instructions.

Bluetooth Wireless Connection Tips

- Make sure the Bluetooth capability of your device is turned on.
- Make sure there's nothing plugged into the Canz speaker's LINE IN jack when you're trying to use Bluetooth.
- The Canz Bluetooth wireless connection works up to a range of roughly 33 feet (10 meters). This range may vary, however, based on other factors, such as room layout, wall material, obstacles, your device's Bluetooth performance, etc. If you're having problems connecting to the Canz speaker, move closer to it.
- Make sure your device supports audio transfer A2DP.
- If your device asks you for a password to connect, use "0000".

Step 5: Play music

Set your device's volume for music to 50%.

Note: This is to make sure the sound from the speaker isn't too loud when you start streaming.



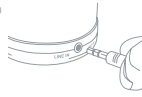
Start playing music or other audio on your device. Within seconds, the speaker starts streaming the audio wirelessly via Bluetooth.



To adjust the volume of your audio: Use the Volume controls on your phone.

Using the Line In

Use the 3.5mm audio cable included with the Canz speaker to connect the audio output from your device to the LINE IN audio input on the speaker's back panel. The speaker automatically switches to the LINE IN audio.



To listen to Bluetooth audio again, unplug the cable from the speaker's LINE IN jack.

Tour of the Canz speaker

Back panel

LINE IN jack lets you connect an audio device directly to the Canz speaker using the provided 3.5mm audio cable.



DC IN jack connects to the provided USB charging cable to recharge the speaker's battery.

CHARGE indicator light shows the charging status of the speaker: illuminated while charging, off when full (or unplugged).

Front panel

PAIR button puts the speaker into pairing mode to connect to a new Bluetooth device, like a smartphone.



PAIR indicator light shows the status of the speaker:

- fast blinking while pairing
- slow blinking while reconnecting
- very slow blinking when disconnected and in standby mode
- solid when paired
- off when the speaker's off (or when the LINE IN jack is in use).

Speaker bottom

ON OFF switch turns the speaker on or off.
